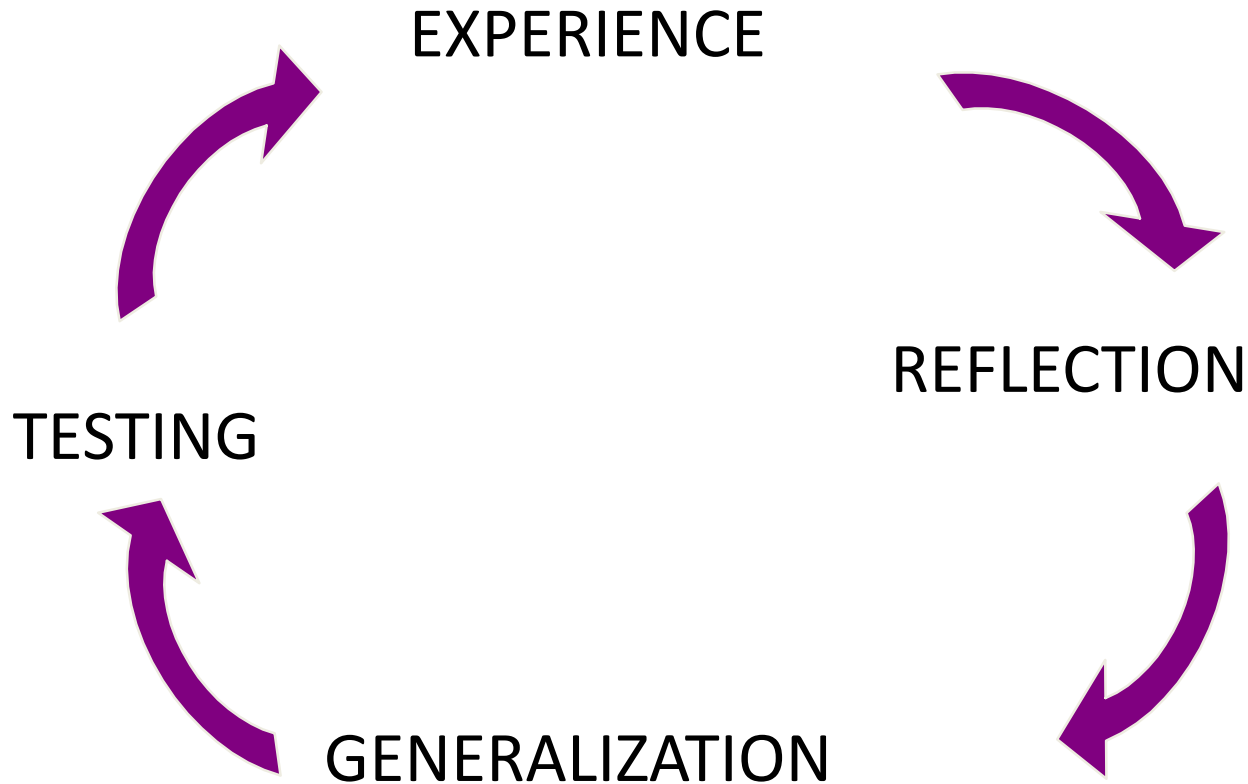








KOLB LEARNING CYCLE



Rules for interaction

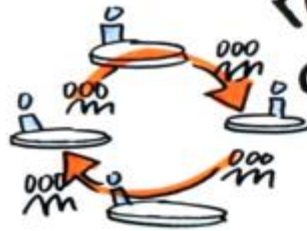
